1 Installation

1.1 Requirements

For the installation of our Shopware step-by-step price calculator plugin, at least the following system configurations are required:

- PHP 7.2 or higher
 - Shopware 6.3.0 or higher

1.2 Installation

There are two ways to install the plugin:

- *Adding via plugin manager in the backend*
To do this, you must first connect the Plugin Manager to your Shopware account. After that, the plugins purchased for this domain are available to you. You can now add the plugin via "Load plugin".
- *Adding via SFTP*
Download the .zip file of the plugin from your Shopware account and unpack it on your PC/laptop. After that, you need to start an SFTP client and copy the unzipped folder to the following directory of your Shopware installation:
SHOPWARE_ROOT_VERZEICHNIS/custom/plugins/

After both variants you still have to install the plugin. You can find the added plugin under "My Plugins" and you can install it via the context button and activate it afterwards.

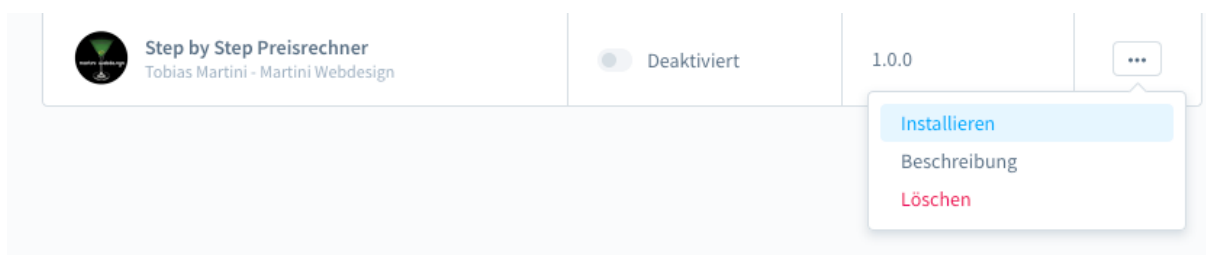


Figure 1: Installing a plugin

2 Setting up the plugin

2.1 Add to an Experience World (CMS Page)

Open or create the Experience World page where you want to display the step-by-step price calculator.

Then open the block editor and select the "Text & Image" tab from the "Block Category" selection menu. There you will find the block "Step-by-Step Price Calculator for CMS Pages". Drag it into the desired page area by dragging it.

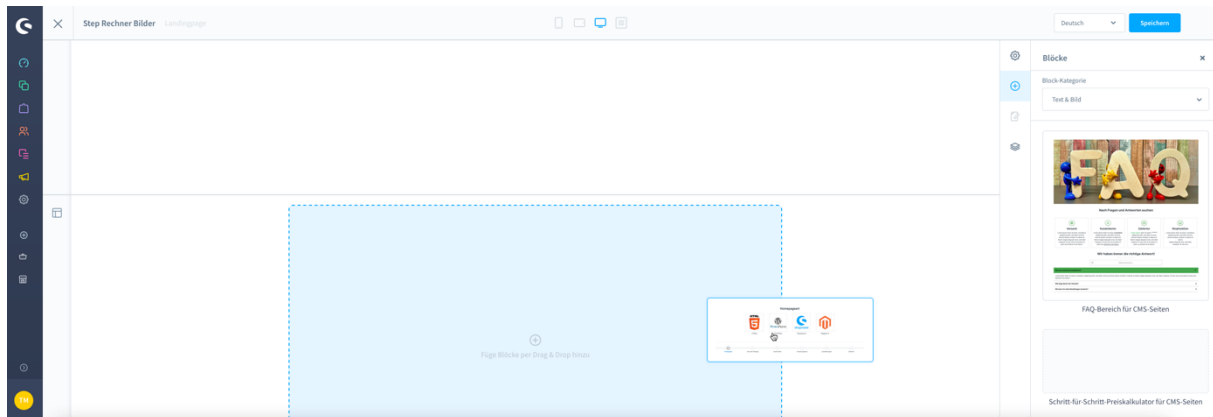


Figure 3: Incorporate the block into the CMS page

Open the block settings

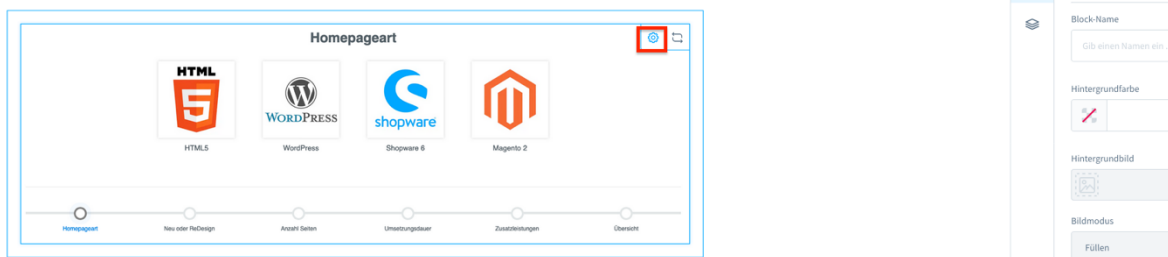


Figure 4: Open Settings

2.3 Basic

In the "Basic Settings" tab, you can decide whether to display images or icons for the selections in the frontend.

In addition, the transition effect to the next step can be set here.

2.4 Layout settings

Depending on the selection of the value in the "ImageorIcon" field in the "Basic Settings" tab, you will find the corresponding adjustment options here. If you select "Image" you can:

- Select the number of items per row
- Turn image shadows on/off
- Define image shadow color
- Hover effect when crossing the image on/off
- Turn the text of the selection option on/off
- Determine the text size and color
- Turning the display of the progress bar on/off in general or for tablet or mobile layout

If you select "Icon" you can:

- Select the number of items per row
- Adjust the size and color of the icons
- Turning the frame on/off
- Defining border color
- Turn the round frame on/off
- Turning the display of the progress bar on/off in general or for tablet or mobile layout

2.5 Settings for each step

Depending on the selection of the value in the "Image or Icon" field in the "Basic Settings" tab, you will find the corresponding adjustment options here.

- Enter the heading for the step
- Upload/ select image for selection option or select icon
- Enter the name and value for the choice

You can add as many other choices as you like using the "Add" button.

The last step can be removed via the "Remove" button. Once the data for the selection is entered but once entered, these are not deleted. If the selection is added again, the data is displayed again or can be changed.

2.6 Add/remove steps

Further steps can be added/removed using the two buttons "+" and "-". If data is already entered in one step and it is removed via "-" the data will be preserved and will be available again after the step is activated. A maximum of ten steps can be set.
